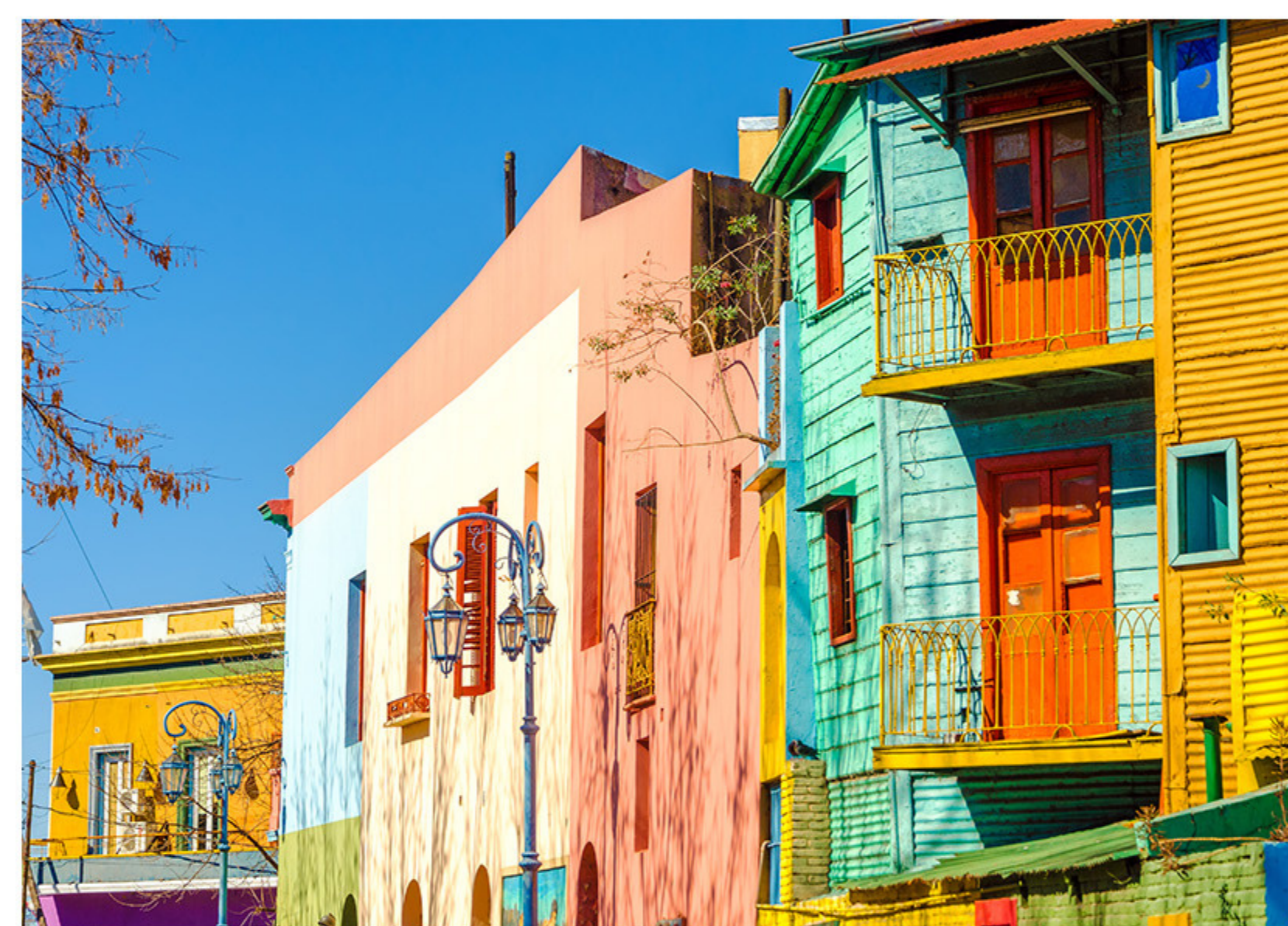

Day 26

Cusco, Peru (*Hotel Stay*)

Once the capital of the Incan Empire, Cusco is believed to be the longest, continuously inhabited city in the Western Hemisphere. On an escorted city tour, take the time to admire the stunning Renaissance-style Cathedral in the heart of the city. Meander through the narrow alleys, lined with ancient Incan walls that echo stories of the past, until you reach Koricancha, a remarkable temple dedicated to the Sun.

Continue your journey in the outskirts of Cusco as you discover some of the most sought-after historic highlights, including the Sacsayhuaman ceremonial fortress, the iconic Qenqo ruins, and the walled Puca Pucara fort. Your Cusco city tour will come to a memorable end in the Inca Baths of Tambomachay, where aqueducts and channels still carry water as they have for centuries, an engineering feat of the ancient Incas!
